- An upcoming meeting is being planned with Sen. Cyr to discuss WWTP project.
- Clear Skies will be coming to visit next month to perform a site survey for solar, charging stations, etc. and any future possibilities.
- Beta Aviation- aircraft charging unit has given a host agreement that is being negotiated.
- Best Alliance is a program the airport has partnered with, the program brings awareness to human trafficking and will be promoting during the month of January.

- WWTF discharge permit has been extended to 2023 due to Covid-19
