Mr. Knabel asked her if it was a 10 or 20 year bond. Ms. Metcalf informed the committee that it was a 10 year bond.

Financial Management Services Scope of Work -

Mr. Knabel asked the committee for feedback on the financial management services scope of work provided by BerryDunn. Discussion ensued. It was agreed that the scope of work as presented included "busy work" that was not necessary. Ms. Martin was directed to work with BerryDunn to refine the scope of work and bring the revised scope of work back for the committee's review at the September meeting.
