



Notice of New Ramp Fees, Effective May 1, 2021

Dear Valued Customer

A review of the ramp fees charged by the FBO was conducted for the first time since December, 2007. During the Martha's Vineyard Airport Commission meeting on January 14, 2021, the Commission approved the following rate structure to take effect on May 1, 2021.

Ramp fees have been adjusted closer to market rates, and are listed in the chart below. The new rates will take effect on **May 1st, 2021**.
